- A creative, open and potentially transformative combination






Why build your Village In The City?

- And... an 'identity' (What makes this a special place?)






Leading as a host – a new (and ancient) paradigm

Others: 'guests'




Leader as servant
Others: 'masters'?








The result of good hosting: engagement
